


The Varsity (approximately 2 blocks from the hotel)

Midtown: Atlanta's Heart of the Arts (*approximately 3 - 5 minutes from the hotel*)

The Woodruff Arts Center serves as the focal point of this activity, with performances by the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra and Alliance Theater Company and exhibitions at the High Museum of Art. Other large venues such as the Fox Theatre offer programming including Broadway shows, Atlanta Ballet and Atlanta Opera performances.

Atlanta Braves and Turner Field (approximately 4 miles, 7 minutes from hotel)
